The Association of The Young Entrepreneurs - BJU - is a forum for young entrepreneurs up to the age of 40 with their own or family-run businesses. The Young Entrepreneurs - BJU have the goal of improving the framework conditions for young entrepreneurs - from business founders to successors. At European level the Association's interests are represented by the organisation YES (European Confederation of Young Entrepreneurs) of which the Young Entrepreneurs have been a member since 1988.
